2020 GOLF OUTING COVID-19 GUIDELINES/PROTOCOLS

In response to the on-going health concerns brought on by the Coronavirus Pandemic there will be numerous changes for the 2020 event to ensure the safety of the participants, staff and volunteers. Below is an outline of the measures the course and organization are taking to ensure the safety of everyone. These guidelines are subject to change without notice. They are as follows:

General Guidelines/Protocols

1. All players/volunteers will be required to complete a COVID-19 survey before starting.
2. Do not attend the outing if you are feeling sick, not well or experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms.
3. Do not play if you have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19, have been residing in an at-risk state, or have been out of the country within the last 14 days.
4. Maintain social distancing of at least 6' at all times
5. Masks are required when entering any building structures or facilities
6. Masks are encouraged for participants that are not in the same household are in a cart together.
7. The event is designed to be outdoor only for this year. Participants should only enter the clubhouse for use of the restroom facilities only.
8. Please remember to use proper hygiene: Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds and use hand sanitizer.

2. Players will be assigned a cart number via email ahead of the event. The cart will have the scorecard, bubble tape (if purchased), hand sanitizer and any other event related items in the cart.
3. Any course games requiring someone on the tee box will be eliminated this year
4. Awards will be announced via email and will coordinate receipt of awards with the team/individual
5. Player must not attend or remove the flagstick.
6. Player must not handle any other players clubs or balls
7. No handshaking
8. Player must mark his or her golf ball for identification.
9. Players must follow social distancing of 6' on practice area putting greens and driving range.

Lunch/Dinner:

1. Lunch for this year will be a grab and good concept
2. Dinner will also be modified from a buffet grab and go

Auction

1. All auction items will be moved to an online bidding system. Winners will be announced within 24 hours.
